Coaches

- i. Believers and followers of Jesus Christ
- ii. Coaches are "volunteers", not seasoned NBA coaches
- iii. All WPC coaches (head coaches and assistant coaches) are required to go through the Live Scan fingerprinting process (i.e. checked against FBI database)

Fees

- i. Registration \$200 for 1st player; \$175 for additional siblings
- ii. Reversible Uniform (top & bottom) \$55 (WPC's colors are purple and white)
- iii. Shoot-a-Thon Fundraiser Winter
- iv. Optional: tournaments, team events, clinics, special practices, etc. (varies by team)

Practices

- i. Saturdays beginning in mid/late October or early November and ending in late February (teams playing tournaments generally have additional practices)
- ii. Practice locations Wintersburg Church, Trinity Presbyterian Church, other gyms (TBD)
- iii. Practice times AM or PM (determined by head coach) (practice location and time is generally set for the entire month makes it easier for parents to plan weekends)

Games

- i. Sundays beginning in December and ending in February
- ii. Game locations Orange County area gyms
- iii. Game times 12pm and later
- Participation requirements
 - i. Every player is **REQUIRED** to participate in **three** (3) WPC approved activities within a one year period (Sept. 1 to Aug. 31)
 - ii. Examples include: Sunday Church Service at Wintersburg Church, Awards Night, Harvest Festival (*October*), Wintersburg Christmas Program, Special K (*Jr. HS group*), Ike Pono (*HS group*), VBS (*Vacation Bible School*), Youth coaches for Little Hoopsters, Pine Valley, Mt. Hermon, etc.

Wintersburg sports ministry (WSM) is formalizing its participation policy for SEYO Basketball. The tables below indicate which activities count toward meeting our requirements. To clarify our policy, we have prepared an FAQ which follows the tables below.

Junior season player: 3 activities per year

3	Vacation Bible School (2nd grade- 5th grade)	July - week long; (counts as 1 activity if only partly attended)
3	VBS Youth Leader (6 th - 8th grade)	July - must attend all sessions

Senior season player: 3 activities per year

FAQ

1. Why are you doing this now?

A written policy facilitates communicating these requirements clearly, consistently, and expediently.

2. Why are some activities weighed so heavily?

The other more heavily weighted activities require multiple days of commitment and thus are weighed more heavily e.g. an activity like Pine Valley Camp is one week long.

3. When do the participation activities have to be completed?

The earlier the better! The absolute deadline is August 31st every year.

4. What happens if a player does not meet the participation requirements?

That player will not be able to play in the subsequent season.

- **5. How are participation requirements monitored?** Each returning player must submit an Individual Player Participation Record at or near the time of registration. The form is available from your team parent or coach. The sports committee along with coaches and team parents are responsible for verifying your attendance at events listed on the form.
- 6. If I attend Sunday school and then attend the church service on the same day, or attend two church services on the same day, does it count as two activities?

 No. It counts as one activity.

WPC SPORTSMANSHIP GUIDELINES-

(Flagrant Fouls, Technical Fouls, Suspensions, SEYO Rule Violations, etc.)

- 1. All players and their parents must sign the WPC & SEYO Code of Conduct (SCC).
- 2. According to the SCC, the player agrees to always respect all officials, all coaches, and any league Commissioner's rulings and decisions.
- 3. According to the SCC, the parent(s) agree to the following:
 - a. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
 - b. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- 4. Since WPC is a church that strives to give glory to God in all we do, players, parents, and coaches of a WPC team are expected to be an example of not just good sportsmanship but great sportsmanship as we are ambassadors for Christ. (all verses from the ESV Bible- English Standard Version)

1 Corinthians 10:31

So, whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 5:20

Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us.

Philippians 2:3

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.

Do all things without grumbling or disputing, that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation among whom you shine as lights in the world...

- 5. In the spirit of humility and respect for authority, when there is any charge or suggestion of unsportsmanlike conduct (flagrant foul, technical foul, suspension, complaint by commissioner, conflicts between parents, etc.), the Head Coach MUST inform the WPC Sports Committee (WPCSC) within 24 hours (email: sportscommittee@wpcsportsministry.org)
 - a. The WPCSC in turn will email the coach an electronic form(s) requesting detailed information about the incident which occurred.
 - b. The coach will then forward the forms to ALL WPC individuals involved as follows:
 - i. If a WPC player is involved; player, parent and coach must each submit a form.
 - ii. If only parent is involved; parent and coach must each submit a form.
 - iii. If only a coach (Head or Assistant) is involved; only coach needs to submit a form.
 - c. Upon receipt of the forms from coach, player, and/or parent, the WPCSC will conduct a review over the next 3 days and determine what actions, if any, are appropriate. This may include player suspension, parent suspension, and/or coach suspension. An automatic player suspension ensues if all involved parties fail to submit the incident form by Wednesday midnight following the game in which the incident occurred (as this would not allow adequate time to do a thorough investigation by the next game. If the incident involves the last game of the season, any suspension will occur and be enforced the following season. A player will not be granted a release to another organization until the incident is resolved.
 - d. Parties involved may be required to attend face to face meetings with members of the WPCSC and/or SEYO board at the discretion of the WPCSC.
